- **Sicherung der Grundbedürfnisse** (z.B. SGB II, SGB XII)
- **Eigenverantwortlichkeit**: Leben in starker Eigenverantwortlichkeit (z.B. § 1 SGB II, § 1 SGB VIII, § 11 SGB XII) und Fähigkeiten zur Hilfe zur Selbsthilfe (z.B. § 1 SGB I, § 11 SGB XII)
- **Teilhabe** als „aktive Teilhabe am Leben in der Gemeinschaft“ (§ 11 SGB XII)

Insbesondere im Jugend- und jungen Erwachsenenalter haben junge Menschen spezifische **Kernherausforderungen** zu bewältigen – im Besonderen die **schwer erreichbaren jungen Menschen**. Wie der 16. Kinder- und Jugendbericht zuletzt aufgezeigt hat, geht es gerade in der Phase zwischen 15 bis 25 Lebensjahren um „Qualifizierung, Selbstpositionierung und Verfestigung“ als Kernherausforderungen des Jugendalters. Das Jugendalter wird gegenwärtig so stark wie nie zuvor durch den Besuch von Bildungssituationen geprägt. Anders gesellschaftliche Erwartungen an junge Menschen treten im Vergleich zum Erwerb von Qualifikationen und Zertifikaten deutlich in den Hintergrund. Jugend ist aber mehr als eine Phase der Qualifizierung, sie ist auch eine Zeit der Selbstpositionierung und Verfestigung. Daher stellt sich die Frage, wie die Kernherausforderungen der Qualifizierung, der Selbstpositionierung und der Verfestigung im Alltagleben junger Menschen bewältigt, gestaltet und in ein konstruktives Verhältnis gebracht werden können. Dies setzt voraus, ebenfalls neu zu klären, wie Jugend im institutionellen Gefüge des Aufwachsens ermöglicht wird“ (BMFSFS, 2018, 70).
